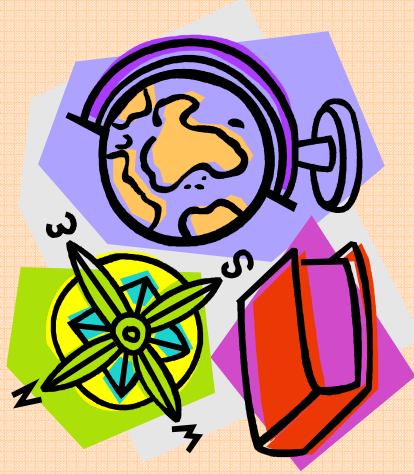

Statistics

Worldwide- 18.8% of the population can't read
2006- 50% of the population in least developed countries are literate
Africa- 53.9% of the female population have the ability to read
Southwest Asia- 58.7% of the general population is Literate

National Literacy

Statistics

2002- 36% fourth graders, 25% eighth graders, and 36% twelfth graders read below basic level
2003- ¾ high school students graduated in 4 years
2004- 3/10 eighth grade students read at or above grade level
2006- 8 million students in grades 4-12 have Trouble reading, writing, and comprehending
Current- 40% fourth graders read below basic level
